
#### **SHOW - RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

We sell beef, lamb, pork and chicken, also 1/2 or whole lambs. During the winter we stock wild Scottish venison in

joints, burgers and sausages Farm-produced firewood & Swedes are available during the winter.

> All our dry cured bacon, burgers and sausages are hand made in small batches on the premises.

We do not have conventional opening hours, due to Pant-y-beili being a real working farm of 140 acres, on which we keep Welsh Mountain cross Suffolk breeding ewes and produce Texel cross lambs which produce leaner and excellent tasting meat.

The suckler cows are Charolais and Belgian Blue cross Limousin and we are using a Hereford bull to produce our excellent quality beef.

A small herd of outdoor pigs are also kept on the farm and are Landrace cross, on which we use the native rare breed Welsh boar which produces high quality lean and very good eating pork and bacon.

The meat animals are fed on grass, cereals (oats and barley) and Swedes which are all grown on the farm. Our flock of egg laying hens are fed on NON GMO layers pellets and mixed corn.

My family on both sides have been farming for countless generations, so when the shop is not open, we are not on holidays.
